1997/98 saw the introduction of a Final Six, necessitating a three-weekend finals series. Melbourne Uni qualified second and were drawn to play Hawthorn Waverley (5th) in this Qualifying Final. After a good start, the Student's innings fell away, losing their last nine wickets for just 66. The Hawks' reply began disastrously, being 4/8 as Ashley Robertson and Justin Dery each took four wickets. Apart from skipper Peter Roach (45), the batting by the Hawks fell away.

Melbourne Uni's Peter Harper, aged just 20, won the Jack Ryder Medal and the Students also won the VCA Club Championship, but they were thumped by Melbourne, the eventual Premiers, in the semi final the following week. Demon pair Warren Ayres (1119 runs @ 65.82) and Steve McCooke (47 wkts @ 19.70) headed the VCA batting and bowling aggregates. 1997/98 was Melbourne's 18th and most recent flag. At that stage, the Demons held a lead of five over St Kilda, a gap which has since closed.
